### Wyre Forest Nightstop and Mediation:

- **Support for Young People who are homeless, at risk of homelessness or in crisis** via telephone, email, WhatsApp and our social media channels.
- **Supporting Young People's mental wellbeing** through our trained staff contacting young people we work with to reduce their social isolation and offer a friendly ear.
- **Mediation and Counselling** on the telephone or via video conferencing with our experienced mediators and counsellors.
