



## ROLE DESCRIPTION

**Mediator Worcestershire (35hrs pw) flexi-hours/job share considered**  
**Salary from £26,000 (unqualified) to £28,000 (qualified), depending on experience.**

Initial 1-year contract (subject to probationary review) with intention to renew subject to further funding.

We are a local charity providing emergency accommodation for young people aged 16-25 who are homeless, or at risk of homelessness. We also offer a confidential, voluntary and impartial Mediation service for young people aged 11-25 and their parent/carer to strengthen family relationships and reduce conflict. Our main office is based in Kidderminster.

### Your Role

This is an exciting role within our Mediation service which is aimed at early prevention and intervention work to strengthen relationships and improve the emotional wellbeing of young people and their families. You will be working with vulnerable young people aged 11–25, experiencing family conflict and possible homelessness.

### You will:

- manage a caseload of mediation cases.
- work in schools in the Wyre Forest and Worcestershire.
- work in partnership with voluntary and statutory services.
- record and monitor case work using an In-Form database.
- undertake regular practice supervision.
- attend regional and national meetings and any other events as required.

### You will need:

- L4 qualification in Mediation or willingness to train within the first 3 months.
- experience of working with young people under 18yrs.
- an ability to demonstrate a willingness to work with disadvantaged young people and their families.
- a flexible, motivated and positive attitude.
- to be prepared to travel across Worcestershire.
- full UK driving license.
- full enhanced DBS certificate.
